## 1. NMS Fellowships for MPhil and PhD Scholars

Nepal Mathematical Society (NMS) is pleased to call for applications from all PhD scholars and MPhil students of mathematics registered at Nepali universities for NMS fellowships for the year 2025. The fellowship will support NRs. 50,000/-each for PhD scholars and NRs. 25,000/- in two installments for MPhil students. This award is meant for supporting some academic purposes like conference attendance/presentation or publications. The deadline for the submission of the application is **April 23**, **2025** (**Baishakh 10, 2082**). ## For PhD Scholars

- 3. Recommendation of the supervisor (only one page)
- 4. CV (signed; max. 3 pages)
- 5. Conference/Workshop/Seminar attendance and presentation with certificates/schedule/abstract/presented poster (whatever are available as proof)
- 6. Published articles (international, national, proceedings, etc.)
  - a) National: maximum of 2 review/general, and 3 research
  - b) International: maximum of 2 review/general, and 3 research
- 7. Project reports: maximum of 1
- 8. Scanned copy of the Certificate of completion of the coursework (for PhD scholars without MPhil)
- 9. Scanned copies of Academic transcripts/Mark-sheets (from Bachelor to the latest degree)

#### **For MPhil Students**

- 1. Cover letter/Statement of purpose
- 2. CV (Signed; max. 2 pages)
- 3. Recommendation letter of the Head/Program coordinator with the date of enrolment.
- 4. Published articles (international, national, proceedings, etc.)

(maximum of 3 national and 2 international)

5. Scanned copies of Academic Transcripts/Mark-sheets (from Bachelor to latest degree/year)

## 2. Dr. Shankar Raj Pant Research Award

**Dr. Shankar Raj Pant Research Award** is established with the financial support of Prof. Dr. Shankar Raj Pant under the guardianship of Nepal Mathematical Society. Prof. Pant is a former president of Nepal Mathematical Society, and a former faculty and HoD of the Central Department of Mathematics, Tribhuvan University, Kathmandu Nepal. This award aims to provide a Nepali research scholar pursuing doctoral degree from Nepalese Universities in the field of Mathematical Sciences each year. To be nominated for Dr. Shankar Raj Pant Research Award, the concerned research scholar must have published outstanding original scientific research articles in the field of mathematical sciences in reputed international/national Journals. The award comprises a certificate, Token of Love, and NPR 20,000/-.

In general terms, the publication must be of exceptional scientific quality. More specifically, the publication must meet the following criteria.

- 1) Creativity and originality/novelty:
- 2) Importance and usability for science
- 3) Presentation: well-structured with a coherent and consistent methodological order that ensures intelligibility of what is being said, and with a logical conclusion.

- Letter of enrolment from the institution.
- Supervisor's recommendation letter
- A copy of the concerned article (Published during 26 March 2024 25 March 2025).
