

Application call for Dr. Shankar Raj Pant Research Award

Nepal Mathematical Society (NMS) calls the applications for Dr. Shankar Raj Pant Research Award. Please circulate the message to anyone you find eligible to apply.

Dr. Shankar Raj Pant Research Award is established with the financial support of Prof. Dr. Shankar Raj Pant under the guardianship of Nepal Mathematical Society. Prof. Pant is a former president of Nepal Mathematical Society, and a former faculty and HOD of Central Department of Mathematics, Tribhuvan University, Kathmandu Nepal. This award aims to provide to a Nepali research scholar pursuing doctoral degree from Nepalese Universities in the field of Mathematical Sciences each year. To be nominated for Dr. Shankar Raj Pant Research Award, the concerned research scholar must have published outstanding original scientific research articles in the field of mathematical sciences in reputed international/ National Journals. The award comprises a certificate, Token of Love and NPR 20,000/-.

Evaluation Criteria

1. Article based evaluation = 80%
2. Experts' Evaluation = 20%

In general terms, the publication must be of exceptional scientific quality. More specifically, the publication must meet the following criteria.

1) Creativity and originality:

How novel is the research?

2) Importance and usability for science:

What is the importance of the research, and has it been broadly acknowledged regarding its importance and usability for further development of science?

3) Presentation:

Well-structured with a coherent and consistent methodological order that ensures intelligibility of what is being said, and a logical conclusion.

Necessary documents:

A submission should contain the following documents.

- A cover letter explaining why the publication should be considered for the Research Award; this explanation must address each criterion (see above)
- Letter of enrollment from the institution.
- Supervisor's recommendation letter
- A copy of the article concerned (Published between 26 March 2020 - 25 March 2022).
- Filled out form of the article details (attached with this notice)
