Scope of the conference

The theme of the conference is “**Mathematics in Nepal: fundamentals, teaching and applications**”. The main objective of the conference is to bring together mathematicians, researchers and students together in one platform to interact with each other to share their knowledge and experience as well as exchange views and discuss the topics of mutual interests in this challenging and widely applied area of mathematical sciences. The aim of the conference is to offer the participants an opportunity to be familiar with the current developments in the subject and acquaint the participants with the research and other mathematical activities in Nepal. The Conference will also provide opportunity to students interact with senior mathematicians coming from different parts of the country and familiarize with the activities being carried at different institutions.

Call for papers and Abstract

Papers related to research, expository articles to introduce recent mathematical advancement, and applications of mathematics are invited. 250 words indicating clearly the objective. Full papers have to be submitted latter in A4 size paper typed in double spacing to the secretary of scientific committee. **Abstract must include:** Title of paper in Capital letters, full address of author(s), abstract, key words.
